Re: OIG Investigation Results in Sentence of Former Circuit Court Judge Davis

Based on an investigation by the Office of the Inspector General, former Circuit Court Judge Phillip S. Davis (Davis) was convicted in November 2009. Davis was sentenced on Friday, January 8, to 20 years in state prison followed by 10 years of probation. His assistant, Joan Marie Headley (Headley), was sentenced to 10 years in state prison followed by 10 years of probation. Last November, Davis and Headley were each found guilty of one count of Organized Scheme to Defraud, one count of Aggravated White Collar Crime, two counts of Grand Theft and five counts of Money Laundering.

Davis and Headley, Director and Administrative Assistant, respectively, of Miami Dade Resident College (MDRC) were convicted of defrauding Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida of approximately \$80,000. The fraud was in connection with MDRC's receipt of three grants awarded in 2002 by the Miami-Dade Housing Agency (now referred to as the Public Housing Agency) and a State of Florida grant.
